- There are two types of health care plans available: an Indemnity plan called the Quality Care Health Plan (QCHP), and two Managed Care plans:

   Health Management Organization Plan (HMO) and an Open Access Plan (OAP). Not all Managed Care plans are available in all areas.
- Champaign County only has these 5 options
  - Quality Health Care Plan State Managed, Most Comprehensive, Use anywhere in the country, International Coverage Available
    - Can pick any doctor
  - Out-of-pocket expenses are significantly increased when using a NON-QCHP network provider or facility
